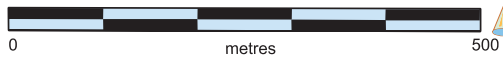

Scale 1:8000 Contour interval 4m

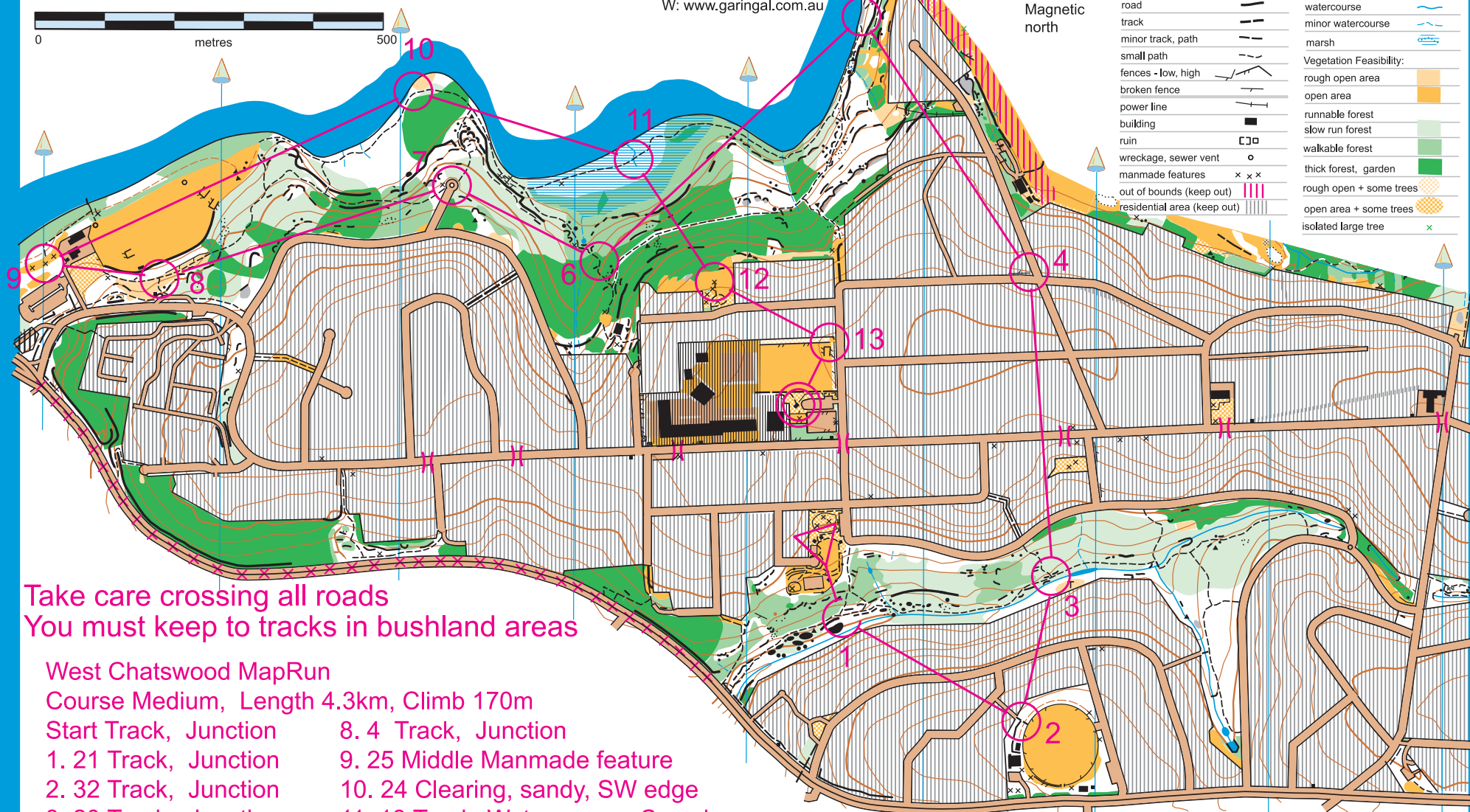
