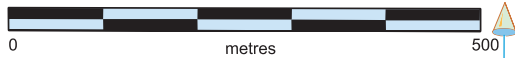


# West Chatswood

Scale 1:8000 Contour interval 4m

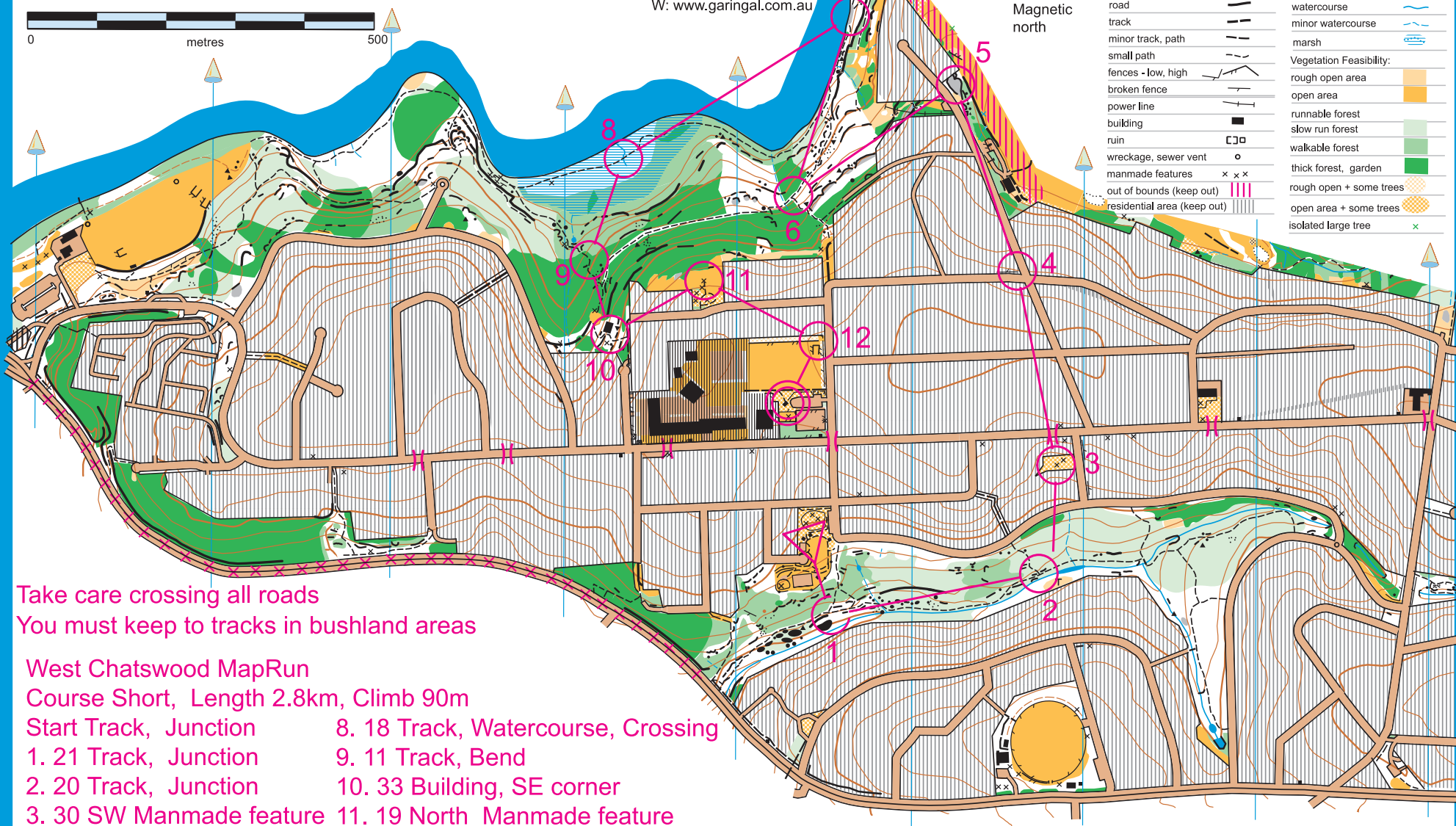

9. 11 Track, Bend

10. 33 Building, SE corner

11. 19 North Manmade feature

12. 6 Fence, East end
